

Shopping Cart Progress Bar

Free Magento 2 Extension



Extension description

Motivate your customers to spend more by giving them some benefit (free shipping, free product or extra discount) once shopping cart subtotal reaches a predefined threshold amount.

Our extension displays Progress Bar at the top of the shopping cart showing how close a customer to get that benefit.

Main Features:

- Easily enable/disable Progress Bar with just one setting switch
- Progress Bar is calculated based on the cart's full subtotal or subtotal minus discount
- Restrict Progress Bar management on the admin role level via ACL resource

Extension Installation

1. Extract the content for the ZIP file to <magento-root-dir>/app/code/
2. `php bin/magento maintenance:enable`
3. `php bin/magento module:enable Freeto_Progressbar`
4. `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
5. `php bin/magento setup:di:compile`
6. `php bin/magento maintenance:disable`

Extension configuration

1. Go to Stores -> Configuration -> Freento -> Progress Bar

2. Turn on the "Enable Progress bar" setting to activate the Progress Bar feature (make sure you fill the rest three settings too)
3. "Progress bar text" setting supports two pseudo variables, calculated automatically:
 - a. {{sum_spend}} - current cart "Subtotal" or "Subtotal - Discount" depending on the "Progress bar is based on" setting value
 - b. {{sum_left}} - amount to spend to reach the threshold
4. Access control management:
 - a. If you don't want some admin roles to access the extension configuration, you can disable the "Freento Progressbar" ACL resource on the admin role edit screen
